



Gunmen grab businessman, grandson in Zambo

ZAMBOANGA CITY, Philippines - Government security forces are in on hot pursuit of a suspected kidnap for ransom group that abducted a Filipino-Chinese businessman and his grandson in a town in Zamboanga del Sur on Wednesday night, officials said.

Police Chief Superintendent Miguel Antonio Jr., Western Mindanao police director, identified Antonio Tan, 70, and his grandson Ryan Nuñeza Tan, 21, as the latest victims of abduction in the region.

Antonio said eight unidentified gunmen seized the two in the presence of terrified family members from their residence in Maruing village in Lapuyan town about 6:05 p.m. on Wednesday.

Maj. Felimon Tan Jr., spokesman of Western Mindanao Command (Westmincom), said the suspects were all equipped with high-powered firearms.

The suspects quickly dragged the victims to the nearby shore and escaped towards the coastal town of Malangas.

Tan said soldiers from the Army's 53rd Infantry Battalion as well as police personnel are tracking the suspects and are working to rescue the victims.

The security officials said no group has claimed responsibility yet in the latest abduction in the region barely five months since gunmen also abducted Italian national Rolando del Torchio, a former priest.

Torchio, 53, now a businessman, was abducted by 10 gunmen from inside his café in Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte.

There were reports of huge ransom demands in exchange for his release, but authorities declined to comment on the case citing concern for Torchio's safety.

5 killed in MILF-Abu Sayyaf clash in Basilan

ZAMBOANGA CITY, Philippines - Five people, including two civilians, were killed in a clash between the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and the Abu Sayyaf group clashed in a remote village in Basilan province on Wednesday, a security official said Thursday.

Maj. Felimon Tan Jr., spokesman of Western Mindanao Command (Westmincom), said a group of MILF fighters led by Aslumin Masud initially encountered the Abu Sayyaf group led by Isnilon Hapilon in the village of Guinanta in Al-Barka town around 9 a.m. on Wednesday.

Tan said reports on the ground indicated three of Hapilon's followers were killed in the firefight, forcing the Abu Sayyaf to retreat.

The Abu Sayyaf group reportedly chanced upon two civilians and executed them while retreating from the clash

The MILF pursued and encountered the same Abu Sayyaf group around 4 p.m. on the same day, triggering another firefight.

The MILF has signed a peace agreement with the government and has coordinated with security forces in operations against outlaw groups in the past.

2 NPA rebels killed in CamSur clash

LEGAZPI CITY, March 24 (PNA) — Philippine Army troopers killed two unidentified New People's Army (NPA) members and recovered three firearms, 618 ammunition and 42 improvised explosive devices in an encounter at 5:55 a.m. Monday at Barangay San Rafael, Lupi, Camarines Sur, a belated report released Thursday said.

The report said members of the 92nd Division Reconnaissance Company of the 9th Infantry Division of the Philippine Army led by 2Lt. George A. Atolba engaged at least 30 NPA men in about 45-minute firefight.

After the last burst of gunfire, government soldiers recovered two unidentified dead male persons and recovered, one M60 LMG rifle (SN 17459) with 347 ammunition; one M16 rifle TM: RP Elisco SN024123 with inserted magazine loaded with 42 live ammunition; one MK 9mm pistol Colt without SN with inserted magazine loaded with 16 ammunition; 213 live ammunition DOE CALIBWE 30; one solar panel, one converter, one 12-volt Motolite battery, one transistor radio, ten backpacks with personal belongings and anti-government documents.

Soldiers also recovered 20 improvised explosive devices (IEDs) placed in a small can, 19 IEDs placed inside a big can; three IEDs placed inside a big plastic pipe, six plastic pipes measuring about four inches long with blasting caps, and two molotov bombs with plastic containers.

All the recovered items are now under the custody of the Army while the two unidentified cadavers were brought to the Sta. Rita Funeral Parlor in Sipocot, Camarines Sur for autopsy.

Lt. Col. Arnel B. Bautista, commanding officer of the Army unit involved in the operation on Monday, said he believes the heightened armed activities of the NPA were related to the celebration of the 47th founding anniversary of the NPA on March 29.

Bautista said they are trying to analyze where the big number of about 30 NPA rebels came from and they suspected that they might have come from different provinces in Bicol.(PNA) BNB/FGS/JH/CBD/PJN

15 rebel returnees in Compostela Valley receive gov't assistance

NABUNTURAN, Compostela Valley, March 24 (PNA) -- Fifteen New People's Army (NPA) rebels who returned to the folds of the law have received cash and livelihood assistance from the national and provincial government of Compostela Valley.

This was bared by the provincial government on Wednesday following the presentation of the 15 rebel returnees by Colonel Macairog Alberto, commander of the 1001st Infantry Pag-asa Brigade of the Philippine Army (PA) and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) to Vice Governor Manuel E. Zamora.

Zamora, who represented Governor Arturo Uy during the Comprehensive Local Integration Program (CLIP) at the Capitol building, gave each rebel returnee PHP5,000 as immediate cash assistance, food packs and other materials such as mosquito nets, blankets for their respective families. They were also given temporary shelter plus meals and other livelihood assistance in a "half way village" in Nabunturan.

Zamora urged the rebel returnees to completely abandon armed struggle and to become productive members of their respective communities and hoping that this will encourage others.

The rebel returnees will also undergo seminars and trainings as part of the evaluation of the Comval Support Units for their educational background such as agricultural production, electrical and other skills and technical education under the CLIP program of the government.

Palace creates nat'l task force for West PH Sea

MANILA - Less than 100 days before President Benigno Aquino steps down from office, the Palace has ordered the creation of a national task force for the West Philippine Sea, which is the subject of an ongoing arbitration case between the country and China before an international arbitral tribunal.

Executive Secretary Paquito Ochoa signed Tuesday Memorandum Circular 94, creating the National Task Force-West Philippine Sea.

The task force will be chaired by the National Security Adviser. The members include representatives from the Departments of Foreign Affairs, National Defense, Justice, Interior and Local Government, Environment and Natural Resources, Energy, Agriculture, Trade and Industry, Transportation and Communication and Finance, as well as the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), the National Coast Watch System, Armed Forces of the Philippines, the Philippine National Police Maritime Group, the Philippine Coast Guard, the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources and such other government officials and private citizens as the chairperson may designate from time to time.

The NTF-WPS shall be composed of permanent representatives from each of the relevant agencies with the rank of undersecretary as regular members. The National Security Council shall provide administrative and technical support to the task force.

The NTF-WPS shall receive guidance from the President, through the Cabinet Cluster on Security, Justice and Peace. It shall be responsible in orchestrating and synchronizing the employment of the different national objectives in the West Philippine Sea and in submitting such reports and/or recommendations to the President through the Security Cluster.

The function of the inter-agency coordinating committee on the West Philippine Sea shall now be transferred to the task force.

The circular also ordered the creation of area-level and tactical-level task forces. The area-level task force shall orchestrate and synchronize the efforts of the different government agencies at the area level.

The area-level task force may create tactical-level task forces composed of units, assets, capabilities and elements of different agencies.

MANILA - Less than 100 days before President Benigno Aquino III steps down from office, Malacañang ordered the creation of the National Task Force for the West Philippine Sea as China continues to flex its naval might in the disputed sea.

Executive Secretary Paquito Ochoa signed Memorandum Circular 94 on March 22, 2016, creating the NTF-WPS to be chaired by the National Security Adviser and composed of the departments of foreign affairs, national defense, justice, interior and local government, environment and natural resources, energy, agriculture, trade and industry, transportation and communication and finance as well as the National Economic and Development Authority, the National Coast Watch System, Armed Forces of the Philippines, the Philippine National Police - Maritime Group, the Philippine Coast Guard, and the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources.

The NTF-WPS shall be composed of permanent representatives from each of the relevant agencies with the rank of undersecretary as regular members. The National Security Council shall provide administrative and technical support to the task force.

The NTF-WPS shall receive guidance from the President, through the Cabinet Cluster on Security, Justice and Peace. It shall be responsible in orchestrating and synchronizing the employment of the different national objectives in the WPS and in submitting such reports and/or recommendations to the President through the Security Cluster. The functions of the inter-agency coordinating committee on the WPS shall now be transferred to the task force.

The MC also orders the creation of area-level and tactical level task forces. The area level task force shall orchestrate and synchronize the efforts of the different government agencies at the area level.

The ATF may create tactical level task forces composed of units, assets, capabilities and elements of different agencies.

China claims most of the South China Sea, through which more than \$5 trillion in global trade passes every year. Vietnam, Malaysia, Brunei, the Philippines and Taiwan have rival claims.

The Philippines is waiting for the decision of a United Nations-backed arbitral tribunal which will decide whether China's claims to the vital sea lane has basis in international law.

Self defense ang ginawa ng mga Pinoy fishermen vs Chinese Coast Guard - AFP

Walang nakikitang masama ang Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) sa ginawa ng mga lokal na mangingisda ng batuhin ng mga ito ang nagpapatrulyang barko ng Chinese Coast Guard sa may bahagi ng West Philippine Sea (WPS).

Ayon kay AFP spokesperson BGen. Restituto Padilla na batay sa kanilang pagkaka-alam hindi molotov bomb ang ibinato ng mga mangingisda sa mga Chinese kungdi mga bato.

Sinabi ni Padilla na ginawa lamang ng mga mangingisda ang tama dahil kanila lamang pinoprotektahan ang kanilang mga sarili dahil kanila itong mga karapatan.

"Ito po ay self defense mechanism na ginawa ng ating mangingisda, ang alam ko po, ang napulot po namin dito ay binato ng bato, hindi po molotov, so kung anuman po ang nahawakan nila karapatan po nilang depensahan ang sarili nila, at dun po niyo nakikita yung pagiging courageous at dauntless ng ating mangingisda," pahayag ni Padilla.

Ayon sa heneral, saludo sila sa ipinakitang katapangan ng mga Pilipinong mangingisda.

Dahil dito nanawagan ang militar sa pamahalaan na madagdagan pa ang kanilang mga kagamitan ng sa gayon kanilang magampanan ang kanilang tungkulin.

" Sana mabigyan po kami ng karagdagang kagamitan para magawa namin ang aming dapat na gampanang tungkulin para sa mga kababayan nating mangingisda, lalo na po sa mga lugar na to, kasi tulad po ng sabi ko, traditional fishing grounds po natin ito, atin po ito, at dapat walang sinuman na magbabanta sa kanila, maaring makapagpigil sa kanilang pangingisda," wika ni Padilla.
