WHEREAS, on 20 December 2019, the Procuring Entity thru the Philippine Army Bids and Awards Committee (PABAC) conducted a Public Bidding for the procurement of supply and delivery of 4 200 200 reverse. procurement of supply and delivery of 1,000,000 rounds Cartridge, 7.62x39mm, Ball and the interested proponent submitted proposal for the Project, and after the initial evaluation and as confirmed in the subsequent Post Qualification conducted by a Post Qualification Team, the proposal made by ARSENAL JSCO., was found compliant to the specified requirements in the Bidding Documents, and other technical/performance requirements which resulted in its consequent declaration as the "Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder";
