Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act". All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post-Qualification Procedures and Awards of Contract shall be governed by R.A. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR.

Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether **local or foreign**, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the IRR of RA 9184.

- **9.** Bid opening shall be on **April 3, 2023 at 1:30 PM** via Video Conference (Zoom). Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

SECTION II. INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

1. Scope of Bid

- 1.1 The Procuring Entity, Philippine Army wishes to receive Bids for the Supply and Delivery of Fabrication of Trailer, Tank, Water (1,000L Capacity), under Bid Reference No. ORD PABAC2 **021-23**.
- 1.2 The Procurement Project (referred to herein as "Project") is composed of 394 units Fabrication of Trailer, Tank, Water (1,000L Capacity), the details of which are described in Section VII (Technical Specifications).

2. Funding Source

- 2.1 The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for **2023** in the amount of **SEVENTY MILLION NINE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS** (Php70,920,000.00).
- 2.2 The source of funding is the General Appropriations Act (RA 11936).

3. Bidding Requirements

- a. The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including its Generic Procurement Manuals and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.
- Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or IB by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.
- c. The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have verified and accepted the general requirements of this Project, including other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, and Coercive Practices

The Procuring Entity, as well as the Bidders and Suppliers, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of the contract. They or through an agent shall not engage in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices defined under Annex "I" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 or other integrity violations in competing for the Project.

5. Eligible Bidders

Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable will be evaluated.

Foreign ownership limited to those allowed under the rules may participate in this Project.

Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have an SLCC that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be at least equivalent to at least;

- 1. For the procurement of Non-expendable Supplies: The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.
- 2. For procurement where the Procuring Entity has determined, after the conduct of market research, that imposition of (a) will likely result to failure of bidding that will defeat the purpose of public bidding: The Bidder should comply with the following requirements:
 - a. Completed at least two (2) similar contracts, the aggregate amount of which should be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) in the case of non-expendable supplies of the ABC for this Project; and
 - b. The largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to **at least** half of the percentage of the ABC as required above

The Bidders shall comply with the eligibility criteria under Section 23.4.1 of the 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.

6. Origin Of Goods

There is no restriction on the origin of goods other than those prohibited by a decision of the UN Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the UN, subject to Domestic Preference requirements under ITB Clause 18.

7. Subcontracts

The Bidder may subcontract portions of the Project to the extent allowed by the Procuring Entity as stated herein, but in no case more than twenty percent (20%) of the Project.

The Procuring Entity has prescribed that Subcontracting is not allowed.

8. Pre-Bid Conference

The Procuring Entity will hold a pre-bid conference for this Project on the specified date and time and either via Video Conference (Zoom) as indicated in paragraph 8 and 11 of the IB.

9. Clarification and Amendment of Bidding Documents

Prospective bidders may request for clarification on and/or interpretation of any part of the Bidding Documents. Such requests must be in writing and received by the Procuring Entity, either at its given address or through electronic mail indicated in the IB, at least ten (10) calendar days before the deadline set for the submission and receipt of Bids.

10. Documents comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

- a. The first envelope shall contain the eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents).
- b. The Bidder's SLCC as indicated in ITB Clause 5.3 should have been completed within the last five (5) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.
- c. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. Similar to the required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.

11. Documents comprising the Bid: Financial Component

- a. The second bid envelope shall contain the financial documents for the Bid as specified in Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents).
- b. If the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder or Domestic Entity, a certification issued by DTI shall be provided by the Bidder in accordance with Section 43.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- c. Any bid exceeding the ABC indicated in paragraph 1 of the IB shall not be accepted.
- d. For Foreign-funded Procurement, a ceiling may be applied to bid prices provided the conditions are met under Section 31.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

12. Bid Prices

Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be entered separately in the following manner:

- a. For Goods offered from within the Procuring Entity's country:
 - 1. The price of the Goods quoted EXW (ex-works, ex-factory, ex-warehouse, ex-showroom, or off-the-shelf, as applicable);
 - 2. The cost of all customs duties and sales and other taxes already paid or payable; iii. The cost of transportation, insurance, and other costs incidental to delivery of the Goods to their final destination; and iv. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, listed in e.

b. For Goods offered from abroad:

- 1. Unless otherwise stated in the BDS, the price of the Goods shall be quoted delivered duty paid (DDP) with the place of destination in the Philippines as specified in the BDS. In quoting the price, the Bidder shall be free to use transportation through carriers registered in any eligible country. Similarly, the Bidder may obtain insurance services from any eligible source country.
- 2. ii. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, as listed in Section VII (Technical Specifications).

13. Bid and Payment Currencies

- a. For Goods that the Bidder will supply from outside the Philippines, the bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies, shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.
- b. Payment of the contract price shall be made in Philippine Pesos.

14. Bid Security

- 14.1. The Bidder shall submit a Bid Securing Declaration or any form of Bid Security in the amount indicated in the BDS, which shall be not less than the percentage of the ABC in accordance with the schedule in the BDS.
- 14.2. The Bid and bid security shall be valid for One Hundred Twenty (120) calendar days from the date of opening of bids. Any Bid not accompanied by an acceptable bid security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as nonresponsive.

15. Sealing and Marking of Bids

Each Bidder shall submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid. The Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid. However, failure of the Bidders to comply with the said request shall not be a ground for disqualification. If the Procuring Entity allows the submission of bids through online submission or any other electronic means, the Bidder shall submit an electronic copy of its Bid, which must be digitally signed. An electronic copy that cannot be opened or is corrupted shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.

16. Deadline for Submission of Bids

The Bidders shall submit on the specified date and time and either at its physical address or through online submission as indicated in paragraph 7 of the IB.

17. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids

- 17.1 The BAC shall open the Bids in public at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in paragraph 9 of the IB. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In case videoconferencing, webcasting or other similar technologies will be used, attendance of participants shall likewise be recorded by the BAC Secretariat. In case the Bids cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the rescheduling requirements under Section 29 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall prevail.
- 17.2 The preliminary examination of bids shall be governed by Section 30 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

18. Domestic Preference

The Procuring Entity will grant a margin of preference for the purpose of comparison of Bids in accordance with Section 43.1.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

- 19.1. The Procuring BAC shall immediately conduct a detailed evaluation of all Bids rated "passed," using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria. The BAC shall consider the conditions in the evaluation of Bids under Section 32.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 19.2. If the Project allows partial bids, bidders may submit a proposal on any of the lots or items, and evaluation will be undertaken on a per lot or item basis, as the case maybe. In this case, the Bid Security as required by ITB Clause 15 shall be submitted for each lot or item separately.
- 19.3. The descriptions of the lots or items shall be indicated in Section VII (Technical Specifications), although the ABCs of these lots or items are indicated in the BDS for purposes of the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.2.6 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184. The NFCC must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.
- 19.4. The Project shall be awarded as One Project having several items that shall be awarded as one contract.
- 19.5. Except for bidders submitting a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NFCC computation, all Bids must include the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.1.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, which must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder. For bidders submitting the committed Line of Credit, it must be

at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.

20. Post-Qualification

Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the Bidder shall submit its latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS) and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the BDS.

21. Signing of the Contract

21.1. The documents required in Section 37.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall form part of the Contract. Additional Contract documents are indicated in the BDS.

Section IV. General Conditions of Contract

1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the **Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).**

2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- 2.1. Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the revised 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the SCC.

3. Performance Security

Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award by the Bidder from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than prior to the signing of the Contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

4. Inspection and Tests

The Procuring Entity or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Project {[Include if Framework Agreement will be used:] or Framework Agreement} specifications at no extra cost to the Procuring Entity in accordance with the Generic Procurement Manual. In addition to tests in the SCC, Section IV (Technical Specifications) shall specify what inspections and/or tests the Procuring Entity requires, and where they are to be conducted. The Procuring Entity shall notify the Supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes.

All reasonable facilities and assistance for the inspection and testing of Goods, including access to drawings and production data, shall be provided by the Supplier to the authorized inspectors at no charge to the Procuring Entity.

5. Warranty

- a. In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty shall be required from the Supplier as provided under Section 62.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- b. The Procuring Entity shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof without cost to the Procuring Entity, pursuant to the Generic Procurement Manual.

6. Liability of the Supplier

The Supplier's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Supplier is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity.

In the case of Goods supplied from within the Philippines or supplied by domestic Suppliers risk and title will not be deemed to have passed to the Procuring Entity until their receipt and final acceptance at respective delivery places.

Intellectual Property Rights -

The Supplier shall indemnify the Procuring Entity against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the Goods or any part thereof.

Terms of Payment -

Expenses incurred related hereto particularly travel and board and lodging expenses shall be borne by the Procuring Entity.

Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, the Procuring Entity may rescind or terminate the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.

TEST AND ACCEPTANCE PROCEDURES FOR TRAILER, TANK, WATER (1,000L CAPACITY)

1. GENERAL

- 1.1. Scope: This Test and Acceptance Procedure shall apply to Trailer, Tank, Water (1,000L Capacity).
- **1.2. Objective:** To determine compliance of the water tank trailer with standards/specifications and operational performance set forth with the end user's requirement.

1.3. Guidelines:

- **1.3.1.** The manufacturer/supplier shall ensure the completeness of quantity stated in the contract prior the inspection.
- 1.3.2. The technical inspection and test of 100% shall be conducted on all samples through visual/physical, measurements and functional to determine the over-all workmanship, completeness, type, material, dimensions and functionality of the item.
- 1.3.3. Technical inspection and test shall be conducted on the allocated samples of the items through performance test to determine the durability and roadworthiness of the item.
- 1.3.4. Results obtained shall be recorded and evaluated to determine the compliance of the items to technical specifications and as basis for acceptance or rejection of the items.
- 1.3.5. The Technical Inspection and Acceptance Committee (TIAC) for Ordnance-Mobility/ Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) Team shall be composed of personnel that have technical knowledge relevant to the items to be inspected.

1.4. Methodology:

- 1.4.1. The Test and Acceptance Procedure (TAP) is divided into four (4) phases:
- **1.4.1.1.** Completeness Inspection Phase This phase shall cover the completeness inspection of the manufactured water tank trailer.
- **1.4.1.2.** Physical, Visual and Functional Inspection Phase This phase shall cover the inspection of the manufactured water tank trailer to include its parts in terms of completeness, workmanship, gauging and functionality.

2. PROCEDURES

2.1. Completeness Inspection

2.1.1. Purpose: The Technical Inspection and Acceptance Committee (TIAC) for Ordnance shall check the completeness of delivered items.

2.1.2. Procedures:

- 2.1.2.1. Physically count the completeness of the delivered items. (If the result is incomplete delivery, do not proceed to the next step and terminate inspection.)
- Randomly draw the sample and allocate sampling for test and inspection (See Para 3.1- Allocation of Sample).
 - 2.1.2.3. Record observation/s.
- 2.1.3. Standard: The delivered items shall be complete during the inspection.

2.2. Physical, Visual and Functional Inspection

2.2.1. Overall Dimensions

2.2.1.1. Purpose: To determine the length, width and height of the water tank trailer.

2.2.1.2. Procedures:

2.2.1.2.1. Measure the overall length of the water tank trailer from the tip of the towing mechanism to the end portion of the leg support using a steel tape or any appropriate measuring instrument.

2.2.1.2.3. Measure the height of the water tank trailer from ground to the highest portion using a steel tape or any appropriate measuring instrument.

2.2.1.2.4. Record results.

2.2.1.3. Standard: The over-all length, width and height shall be in accordance to required specifications.

2.2.2. Tank Inspection

2.2.2.1. Purpose: To determine the workmanship, material, design, capacity, leakage and dimension of the tank and its parts.

2.2.3.2. Procedures:

2.2.3.2.1. Visually and physically inspect the type, workmanship and completeness of the components and parts of the chassis.

2.2.3.2.2. Check for the completeness, type, size and number of studs of wheel.

2.2.3.2.3. Check for the type, dimension and workmanship of the chassis frame and fender extension.

2.2.3.2.4. Check for the type and design of suspension, axle and towing mechanism of the chassis.

2.2.3.2.5. Check for the type, design, material, installation and quantity of fixed step ladder, caster wheel, safety chain and leg support of the chassis.

2.2.3.2.6. Connect the water tank trailer to the towing vehicle and check for the compatibility of towing mechanism to the pintle hook of towing vehicle.

2.2.3.2.7. Check for the voltage of the electrical coupler of the towing vehicle using a meter tester.

2.2.3.2.8. Check for the continuity of the electrical socket of the water tank trailer using a meter tester.

2.2.3.2.9. Connect the electrical socket of the water tank trailer for compatibility check to the coupler of towing vehicle.

2.2.3.2.10. Start the engine of the towing vehicle and press the brake pedal and check if the stop/brake light is functioning when engine is on.

2.2.3.2.11. Move the toggle switch of the vehicle to left and right direction to check if the signal light is functioning.

2.2.3.2.12. Record observation/s.

2.2.3.3. Standards:

2.2.3.3.1. The components and parts of the chassis shall be in accordance to required specification.

2.2.3.3.2. The size and design of the fixed step ladder must be able to accommodate human size foot and provided with anti-slip.

2.2.3.3.3. The components and parts of the chassis shall be brand new, free from malfunction, damages and no sign of poor workmanship.

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
