Higher food, fuel and transport costs pushed infiation nationwide to 5.7 percent last month. the fastest rise in over five years, the government said on Tuesday.

Surging inflation reduced a family's purchasing power of last month

In Metro Manila prices of basic goods and services rose further to 6.5 percent up from 5.6 percent in June and 2.9 percent in July last year.

Inflation in July nationwide marked the fifth straight month the rate has breached the cenita: bani 3-4 persent targei: for this year and next leading some analysis to believe policymakers would delive a rate hiss as much as 50 basis points or Thursday

The inflation rate was near the top end of the central bank's 5.1-5.8 percent estimate for July

Amic rising consumer pri-CGs. the countries economic managery assumed the public that the government was moving to tempor inflation. They said inflation would taber off toward the end of the year.

Food prices surge

In a report released on Tuer day, the Philippine Statistics Authority (FSA) attributed the increase in prices of basic goods

and services to a 7.1-percent year-on-year increase in the price of food and nonaicoholic beverages.

Rice prices have further gone up amid low grain inventory and depleted buffer stock of the National Food Authority.

Declining rice inventory

"Part of the supply problem is the country's declimate rice stock inventory—caused by weather disturbances in the country and in other rice-producing countries like Thailand Propose last year to only kg.430—and Vietnam—which washing a toll on the prices of rice. In the wake of the price increases, workers saw their nocome go down by as much as "P2,700 in the first six months."

Based on estimates of Ibon Foundation, roughly 60 million Filipinos suffered an income loss of around Pogg to Pa.715 because of the higher-than-expected inflation.



Duterte terminated the peace talks with the communist rebets in November last year.

Two weeks after the President signed Proclamation 374, which declared the New People's Army and Communist Party of the Philippines as terrorist groups, triggering a word war with Sison.



FINALLY, after years of on-and-off negotiations, even acrimonious exchanges at times, a way forward is now being drawn up on the contentious South China Sea West Philippine Sea issue.

Coming out of the recently concluded meeting of Asean Foreign Ministers meeting in Singapore. China's Foreign Minister Wang Y, announced that he and his counterparts in the 10-memoer regional grouping have agreed on a draft Code of Conduct on the disputed area.

It appears that this draft was finally accepted by all the parties after it was clearly indicated that "...resolving tensions in the South Chine Soc is an issue only for Chine and its Southeast Asian neighbors to negotiate"

The parties agreed and made clear that "outside interference will only complicate sensitive and complex issues" engendered no end by years of mongled exchanges exacerbated by unending interjections by outside forces. Thus, after 16 long years of drawr outnegotiations, there is clearly light at the end of the tunnel. And the good thing is this not from a speeding wrecker train.

Noted a keep observer of the scene after the parties nailed this critical development as no less than a milescone in China-Asean relations. "The like mindedness attending the agreement of the parties was truly encouraging, with all countries setting aside differing approaches to the problem in favor of working together for a common, single southor. Thus is the only

way to ensure that the contested waters will one day be awash with deoperation, peace and stability."

Foreign Minister Wang Y: put it even more colorfully when he likened the way forward as a process where "China and the Asean are building a house together, with each country having its own idea of what the building should look like and now the groundwork has been set for a single design."

engaged in moving its own post without regard for those of the others, now there is a singularity of purpose and direction. The disputes among the claimant countries. The adoptic draft cone simply titled "Single Draft South Chine Sea Code of Conduct begotiating Text" takes off from the previously adopted "Framework Agreement on the Code of Conduct" which was initialed by the countries years back. As agreed the SDN"

noted that "it is not an instrument to seitle territorial disputes or maritime defineation issues" with a cievarly moexed caveat inserted by Malaysia which read "the parties further acknowledge that the Code of Conduct does not address nor affect the Parties' position on legal questions relating to the settlement of disputes, maritime boundaries, or the permissible maritime entitlements of the parties under international law as enshrined in the 1982 UNCLOS."

It is clear from the discussions and the final output that the agreement reached in Singapore is just the first step in clearing the air as it effectively caling the waters and directs the parties to settle issues peacefully.

Instead of the parties haranguing and showing at each other, the text provides a platform for the parties it engage in discussions without the need of advice or assistance from countries outside of the grouping And only in accord with international law and the age old tradition of civility and non-confrontation.

Sc. even as Foreign Affairs Secretary Alan Peter Cavetano tangles with the likes of former President Aquino and Senator Trilianes, both of whom have now called him a trantor to their earlier cause alliance, the issue over which they have exchanged such acrimonious language is now on its way to being peacefully sertled. And all for the better—for the Philippines and our neighbors.

The fire claimed hundreds of houses from two baranggays in Jolo. Brgy Walled City and Brgy Busbus, and left 20,278 persons homeless with 27 million of total estimated damages It was declared "fire out" at 11:30 in the evening on the same day. 1DPAO / MCAG
